

## Revelation 20

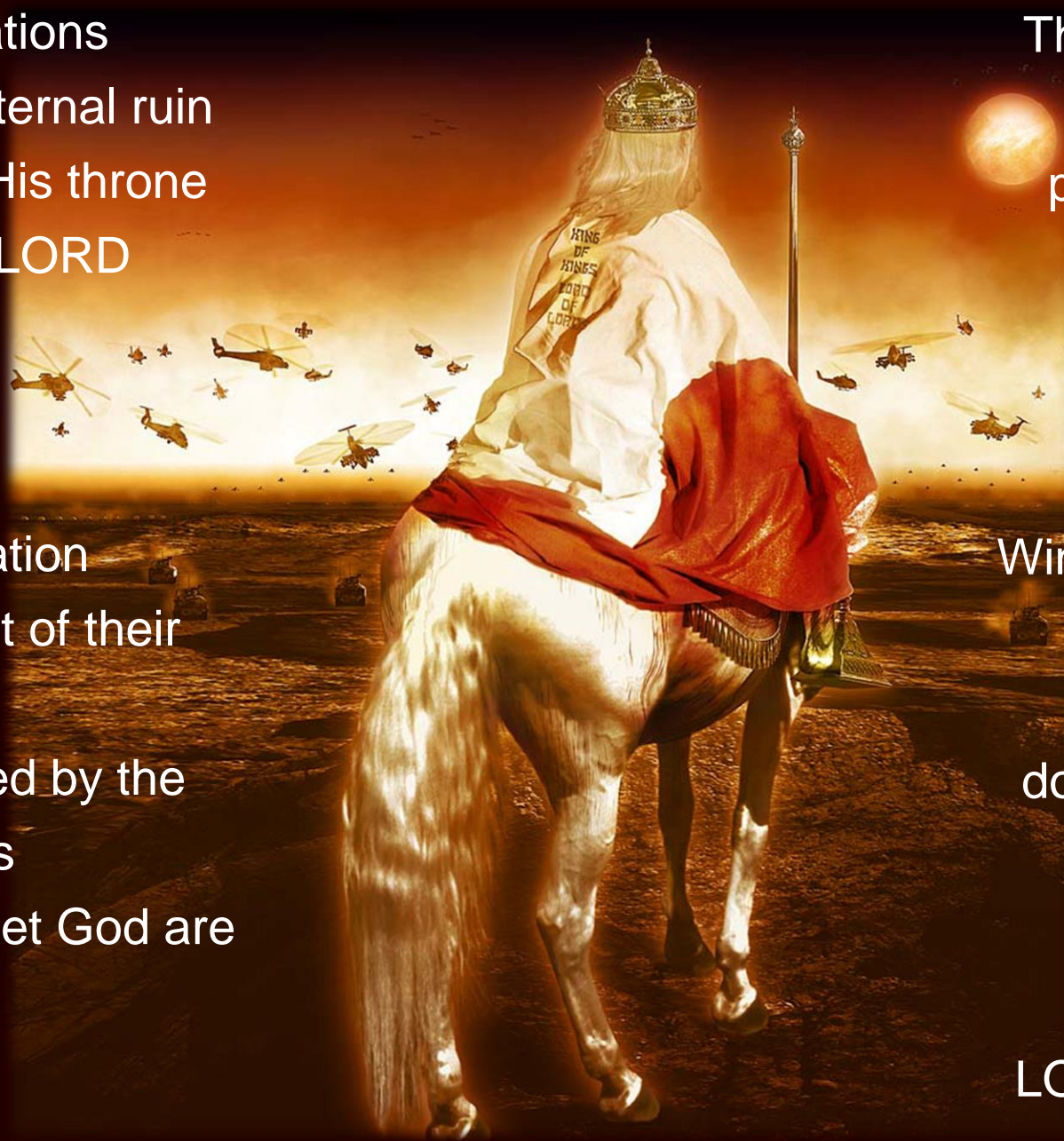
If the wicked are destroyed by God, and the righteous are martyred by AntiChrist, who are the people who enter the Millennium ?

## Ps9:5-18

God rebukes the nations  
Enemies come to eternal ruin  
LORD establishes His throne  
Sing praises to the LORD  
Proclaim His deeds  
among the people

Rejoice in His Salvation  
Nations fall into a pit of their  
own making  
Wicked are ensnared by the  
work of their hands  
All nations who forget God are  
turned to Sheol



## Is24:1-23

The LORD lays waste the earth. He  
twists its surface and scatters its  
peoples. It is defiled by its people.  
They must bear their guilt; few  
survive. From the west, they  
proclaim His majesty. From the  
east, they glorify the LORD.

Windows of heaven open. The earth  
is utterly broken apart: it staggers  
like a drunk; its rebellion weighs it  
down. The LORD punishes the host  
of heaven and kings of the earth.

They are prisoners in a pit,  
punished after many days. The  
LORD of Hosts reigns in Jerusalem,  
before His elders with great glory.

**Is13:1** The burden of Babylon...

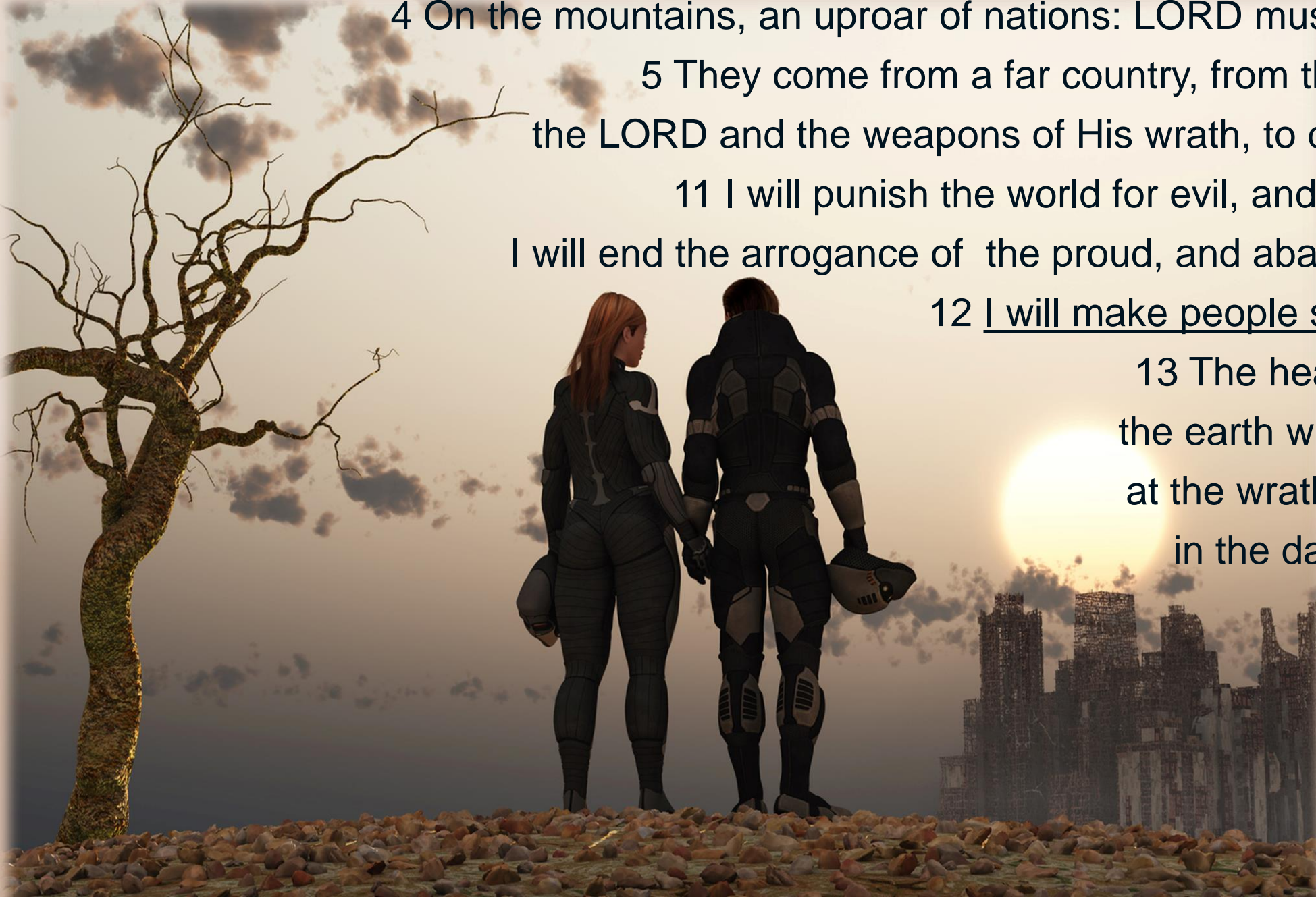
4 On the mountains, an uproar of nations: LORD musters an army for battle

**Is65:19-25** I will rejoice in Jerusalem and take delight in My people. The sounds of weeping will no longer be heard in her. No longer will there be in it an infant who lives but a few days, or an old man who does not fill out his days. A person of 100 will be a youth; anyone who dies before 100 must be accursed. As the days of a tree, so will be the days of My people. They will not bear children for calamity. Adonai will bless them and their descendants. The wolf and lamb will feed together. The lion will eat straw like the ox. No one will hurt or destroy in all My holy mountain

**Is11:6-16** The wolf and lamb, the leopard and kid dwell together, and a little child leads them. The cow and bear graze, the lion eats straw like an ox. They will not hurt or destroy in all My holy mountain: the earth will be full of the *knowledge of ADONAI*, as the waters cover the sea. The root of Jesse stands as a banner. The nations seek Him; His resting place is glorious. He will again gather the dispersed of Israel from the 4 corners of the earth.

Are there really kingdoms ? Who are the ones judging and where did they come from ?

I've always been told the Messiah is the only King

The some of the kedoshim of Messiah are appointed as rulers at the Judgment Seat of Messiah

Messiah does rule over all. But, remember that He is called the King of kings and Lord of lords

## Rev11:15

The kingdoms of this world have become the kingdom of our Lord, and His Messiah, and He shall reign for ever and ever

## Rev19:1

Hallelujah! Salvation and glory and power belong to our God

## Rev20:4

I saw thrones. Seated on them were them given the authority to judge. I even saw those beheaded for the testimony of Yeshua and word of God, and those who had not worshipped the beast or taken its mark. They came to life and reigned with Messiah for 1000 years



## Dan7:9-11

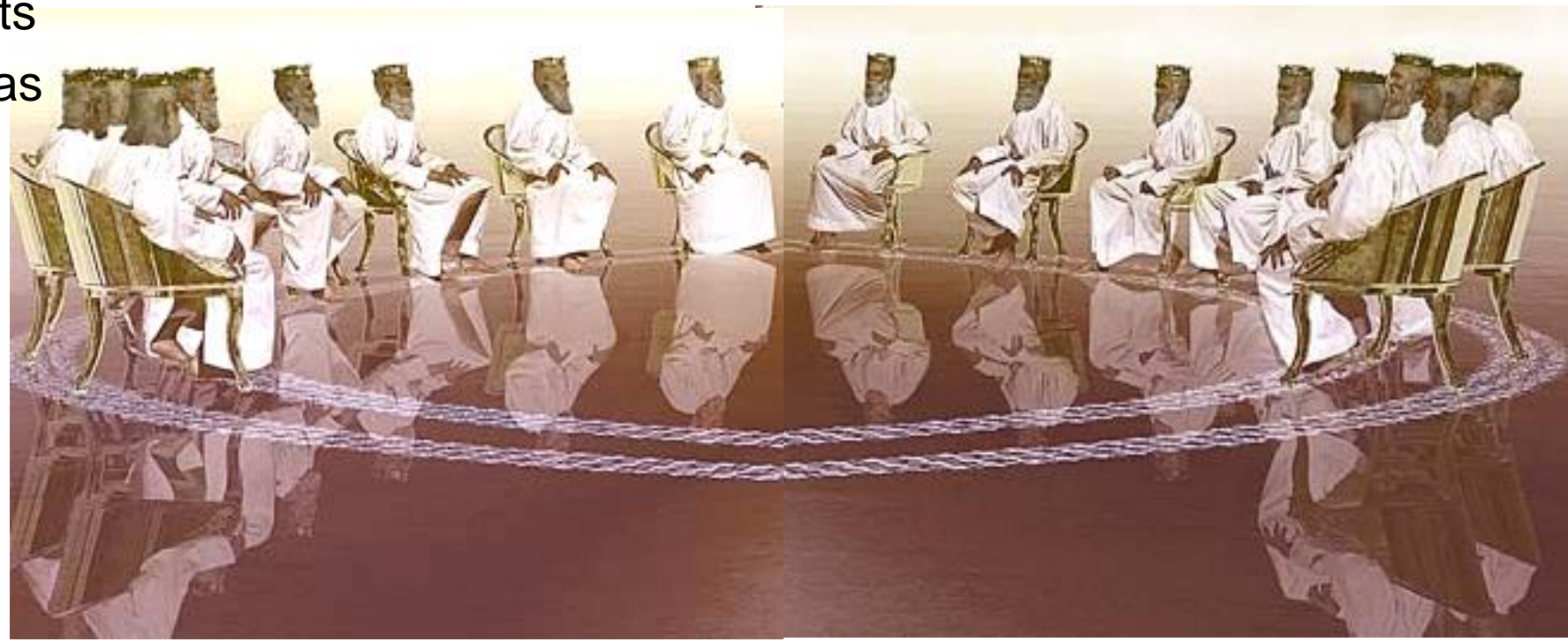
Thrones were set in place. The Ancient of Days took His seat. Myriads attended Him. The court was seated, and books were opened. The beast was thrown into blazing fire. The Son of Man came with clouds of heaven with authority, glory and kingly power. All nations bowed to Him. His dominion is forever. Sovereignty over all kingdoms under heaven is given to the kedoshim of the Most High. His kingdom is an everlasting one. All rulers worship and obey Him

## Lk22:28-30

You are those who have stood by Me in my trials. I confer on you a kingdom, just as My Father conferred one on Me. In My kingdom, you will sit on thrones, judging the twelve tribes of Israel.

## Lk19:15-17

The king returned. The servants to whom He had given the minas came to give account. The 1<sup>st</sup> one said: 'Sir, your mina has earned 10 more.' The master said: 'Well done, My good servant ! You were faithful in a very small matter, take charge of 10 cities.'

Don't you know the saints will judge the world? You should be deciding trivial matters. Don't you know that we will judge angels?

## Ex18:20-25

Moses showed them the way in which to walk. He chose capable men and made them heads over the people, rulers of 1000's and 100's and 50's and 10's. The hard cases they brought to Moses, but every small matter they judged themselves.



**Mt25 Friends of Bridegroom go to the feast  
(these are NOT the bride, but the bridesmaids)**

The kingdom of heaven is like 10 virgins who went to meet the bridegroom. Five were foolish, and took no oil. They left to get oil. The bridegroom came. Those who were ready went into the wedding feast. After the door was shut, the others came. But, He replied, 'Truly, I do not know you.'



***Servants receive their reward: rulership***

It is like a man going on a journey, who hands His possessions to His servants. After a long time, He returns to settle accounts. One had doubled His money. 'Well done, good and faithful servant! You were faithful in a little; I put you in charge of much'

***Separation of the nations: judgment of the living nations to go into the Millennium***

When the Son of Man comes in His glory and sits on His throne, all nations will be gathered. He will separate sheep from goats. The sheep inherit the kingdom: they cared for the least of His brethren  
The goats go to eternal punishment: what they did not care for the least of His brethren

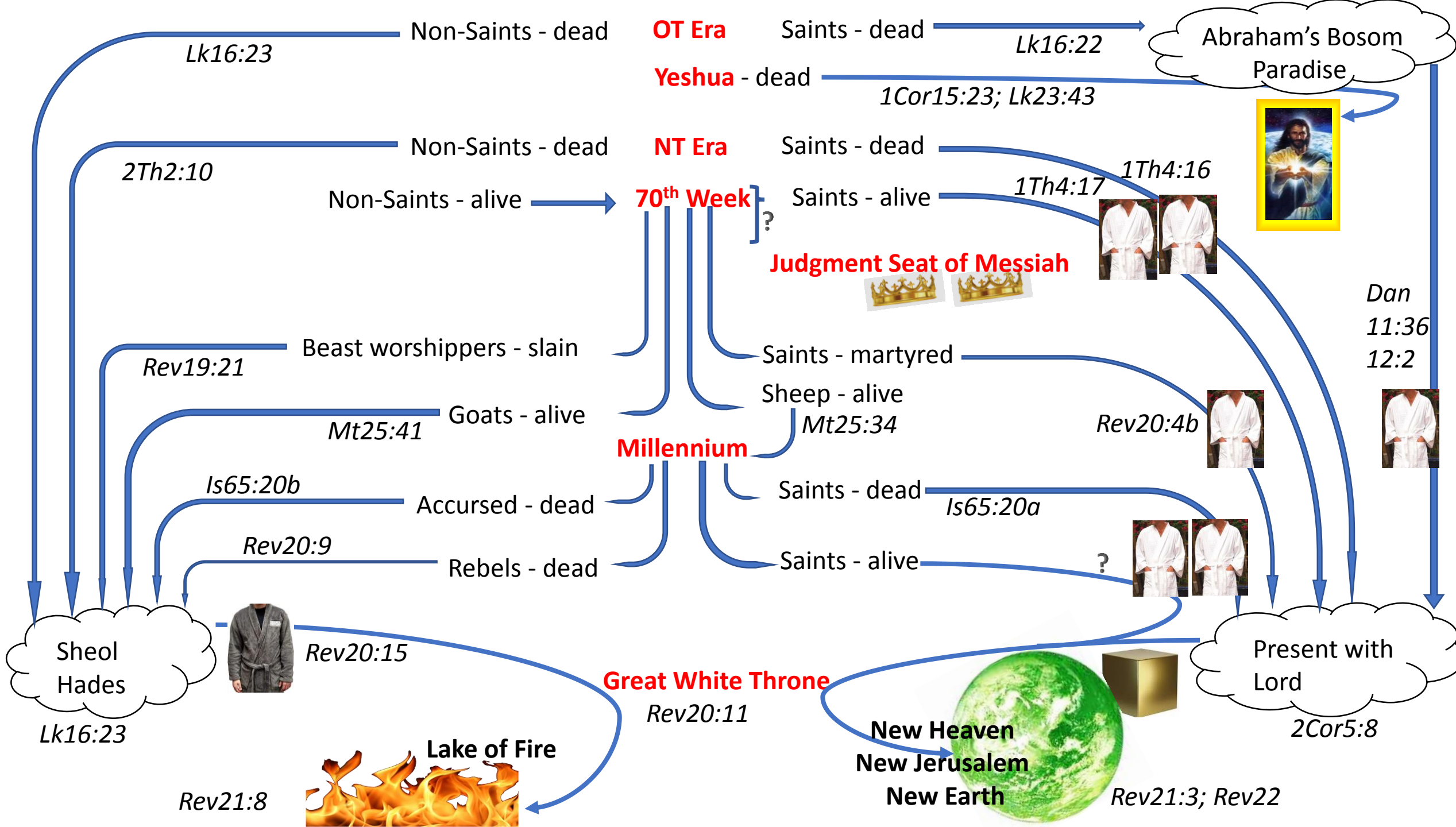
Who goes where ? When ?

What is the order of resurrection ?

I've always been told there is only 1 resurrection

Please see the following chart. The “robe” icons denote a best guess on timing of when various people groups receive the new body.

Revelation does speak of more than one round of resurrection



## Revelation 20

Who are those who are raised from the dead in Mt27

I've been told a small group of Old Testament saints get their new body at this time

The saints in Mt27 who were seen after Yeshua's resurrection were raised at His death.

They were brought back from death BEFORE Yeshua's resurrection.

We know that these are NOT the new bodies, as Messiah is the Firstfruit

## Dead who are raised to natural life

**1Kg17** Elijah raises widow of Zarephath's son

**2Kg4** Elisha raises Shunammite woman's son

**2Kg13** Elisha's bones raise a dead man

**Lk7** Yeshua raises the widow of Nain's son

**Lk8** Yeshua raises daughter of synagogue leader

**Jn11** Yeshua raises Lazarus

**Act9** Simon Peter raises Tabitha

**Act20** Rav Shaul raises Eutychus

**Mt27** *Yeshua dies; tombs break open and many saints are raised (seen after His resurrection)*



## Revelation 20

Who are the people like who rebel at the end of the Millennium ?

Why are they described as being like “sand of the seashore” ?

Large portions of the living nations choose to rebel.

They are dispatched instantly by fire from heaven (significant).

The population is described like the sand of the seashore because they are so numerous.

(Rom9:27; Gen22:17)

With abundance, safety, longevity, peace, no infant mortality, the mankind is fruitful and multiplies



## Assuming:

*Starting population:* 40 people (Noah: 8)

*Longevity:* 180 years (patriarchs: average 567)

*Birth cycle:* every 20 years

*From age:* 20 - 200

*By 1000AM:* 11 billion living

*Total:* 11.5 billion living and dead

*Birth cycle:* every 10 years

*From age:* 20 – 120

*By 1000AM:* 506 trillion living

*Total:* 508 trillion living and dead

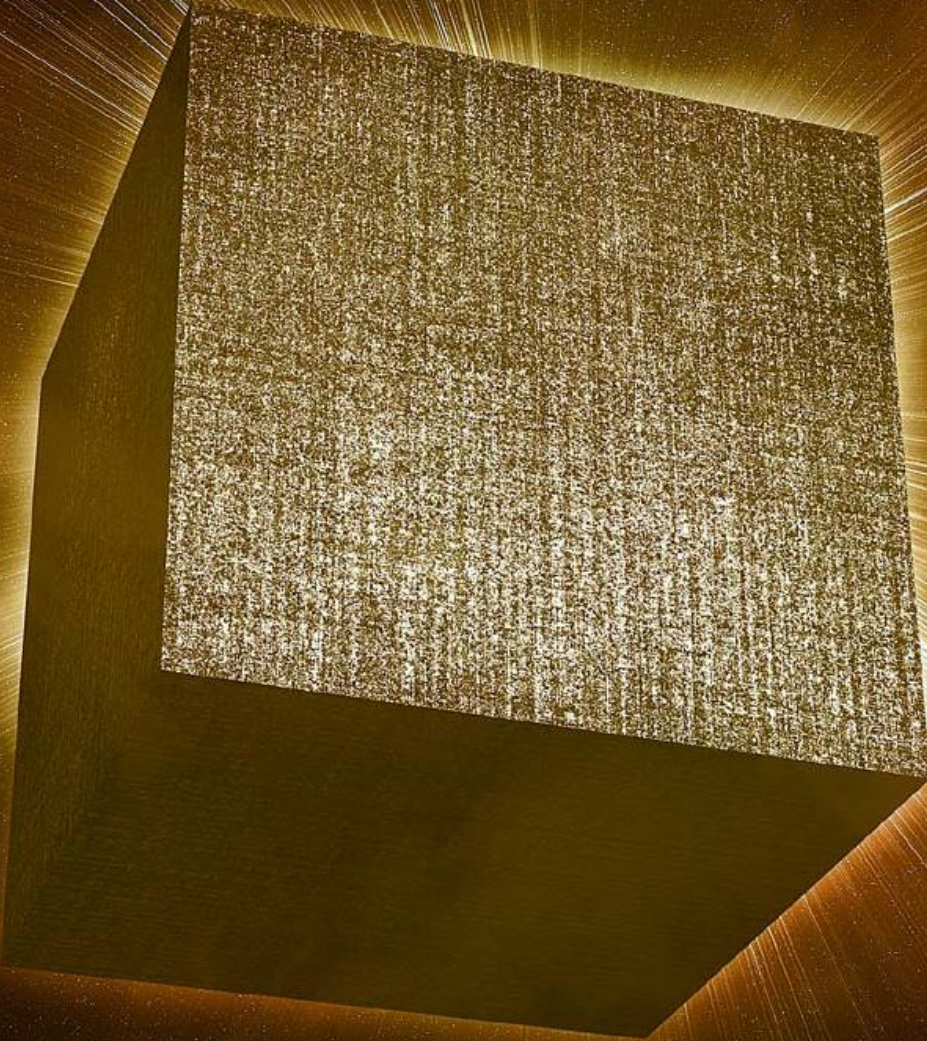

**Rev21:18** The material of the city's wall was jasper, while the city was pure gold, clear as glass.

The sun will no longer light your day, nor will the moon shine on you, for the LORD will be your everlasting light, your God will be your glory.

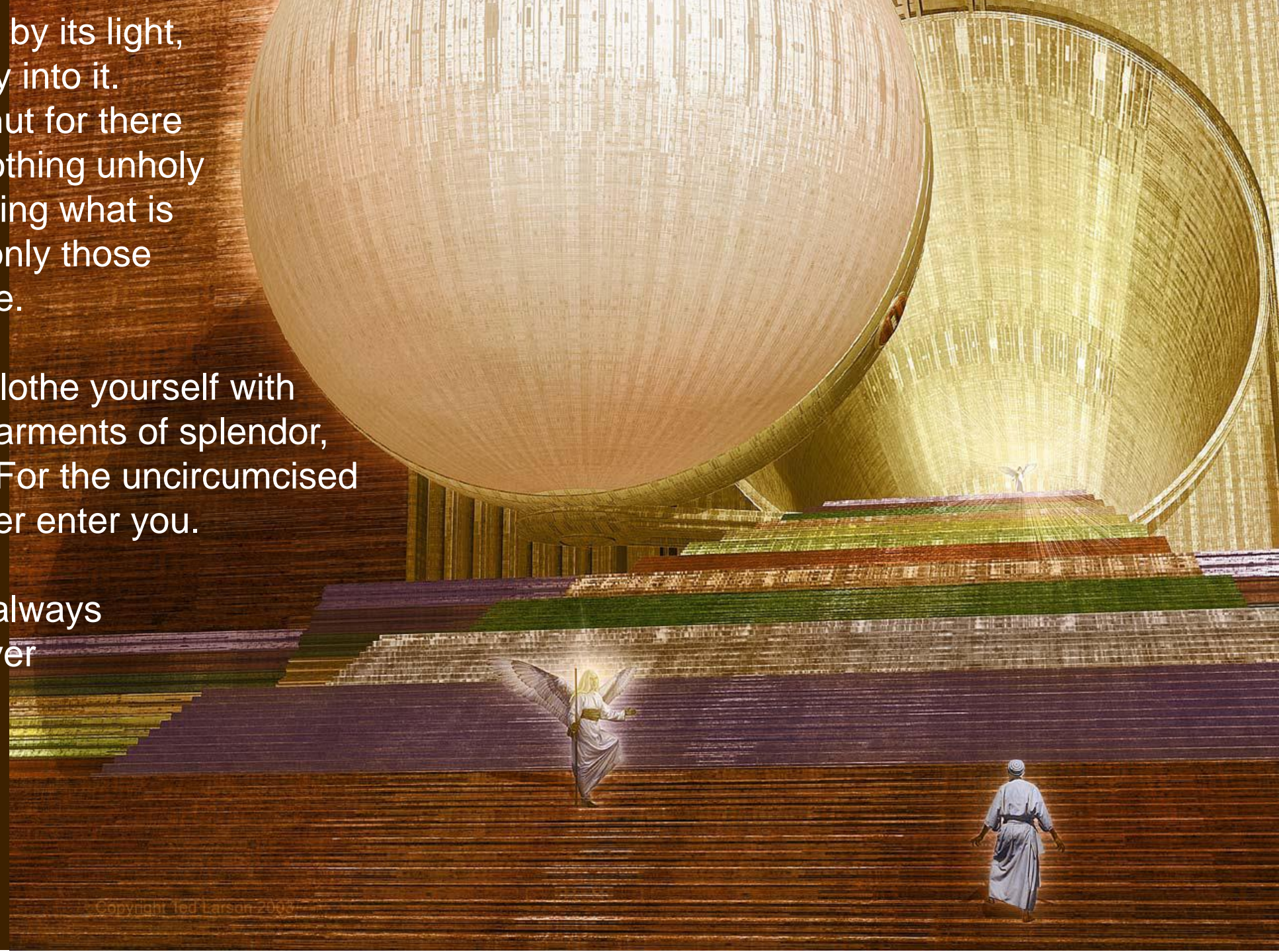




**Rev21** Nations will walk by its light, kings will bring their glory into it. Its gates will never be shut for there will be no night there. Nothing unholy will enter, nor anyone doing what is detestable or false, but only those written in the Book of Life.

**Is52:1** Awake, awake, clothe yourself with strength, Zion ! Put on garments of splendor, O Jerusalem, holy city! For the uncircumcised and unclean will no longer enter you.

**Is60:11** Your gates will always stand open; they will never be shut, day or night, so that the wealth of the nations may be brought into you, with their kings being led in procession.





**Rev22:1-2** Then the angel showed me a river of the water of life, as clear as crystal, flowing from the throne of God and of the Lamb down the middle of the main street of the city.

**Ezk47:1**

Then the man brought me back to the entrance of the temple, and I saw water flowing from under the threshold of the temple toward the east. It was coming down from under the south side of the temple, south of the altar.

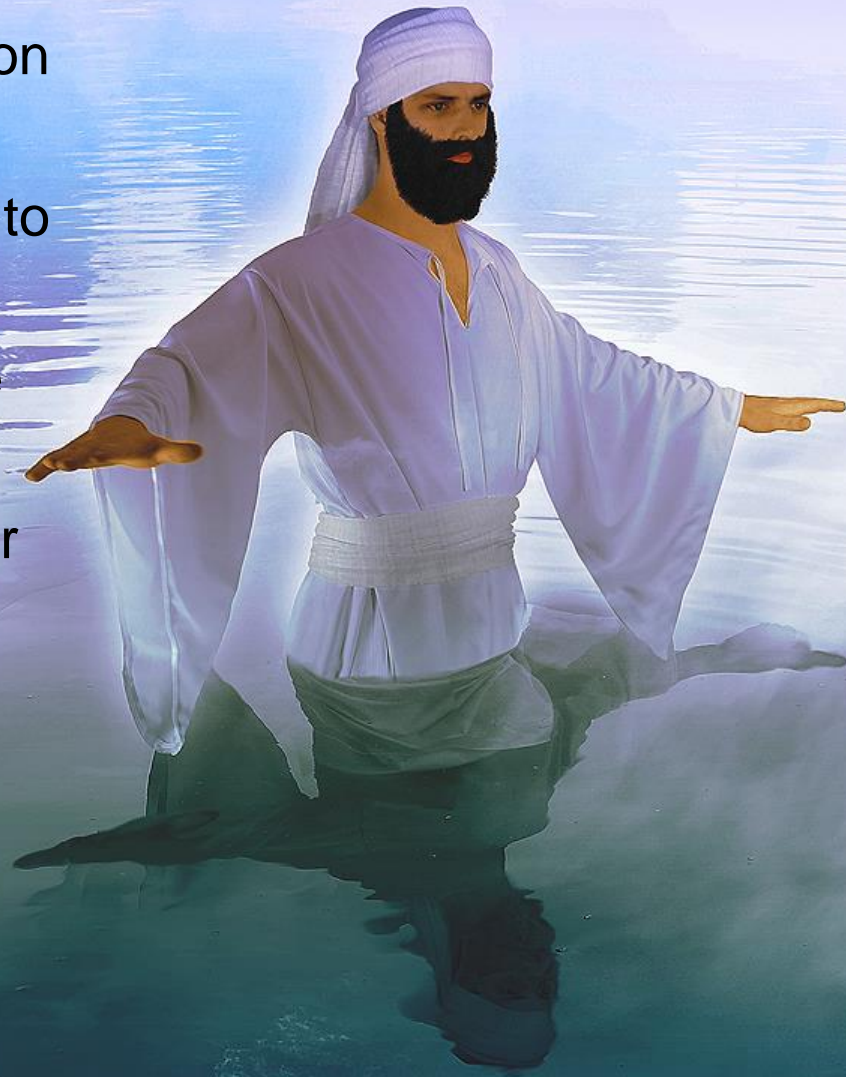
**Rev22:2** On either side of the river stood a tree of life, bearing 12 kinds of fruit and yielding a fresh crop for each month.

**Ezk47:6-7** Then he led me back to the bank of the river. When I arrived there, I saw a great number of trees on each side of the river.



## Ezk47:8 10

This water flows toward the eastern region and goes down into the Arabah, where it enters the Dead Sea. When it empties into the sea, the salty water there becomes fresh. Swarms of living creatures will live wherever the river flows. There will be large numbers of fish, because this water makes the salt water fresh; so where the river flows everything will live. The fish will be of many kinds, like the fish of the Mediterranean Sea.





**Rev22:2** The leaves of the tree are for the healing of the nations

**Ezk47:12** Fruit trees of all kinds will grow on both banks of the river. Their leaves will not wither, nor will their fruit fail. Every month they will bear fruit, because the water from the sanctuary flows to them. Their fruit will serve for food and their leaves for healing.”



**Rev22:4**

They will see His face,

**Rev22:5** There will be no more night in the city. They will have no need for the light of a lamp or of the sun. For the Lord God will shine on them, and they will reign forever and ever

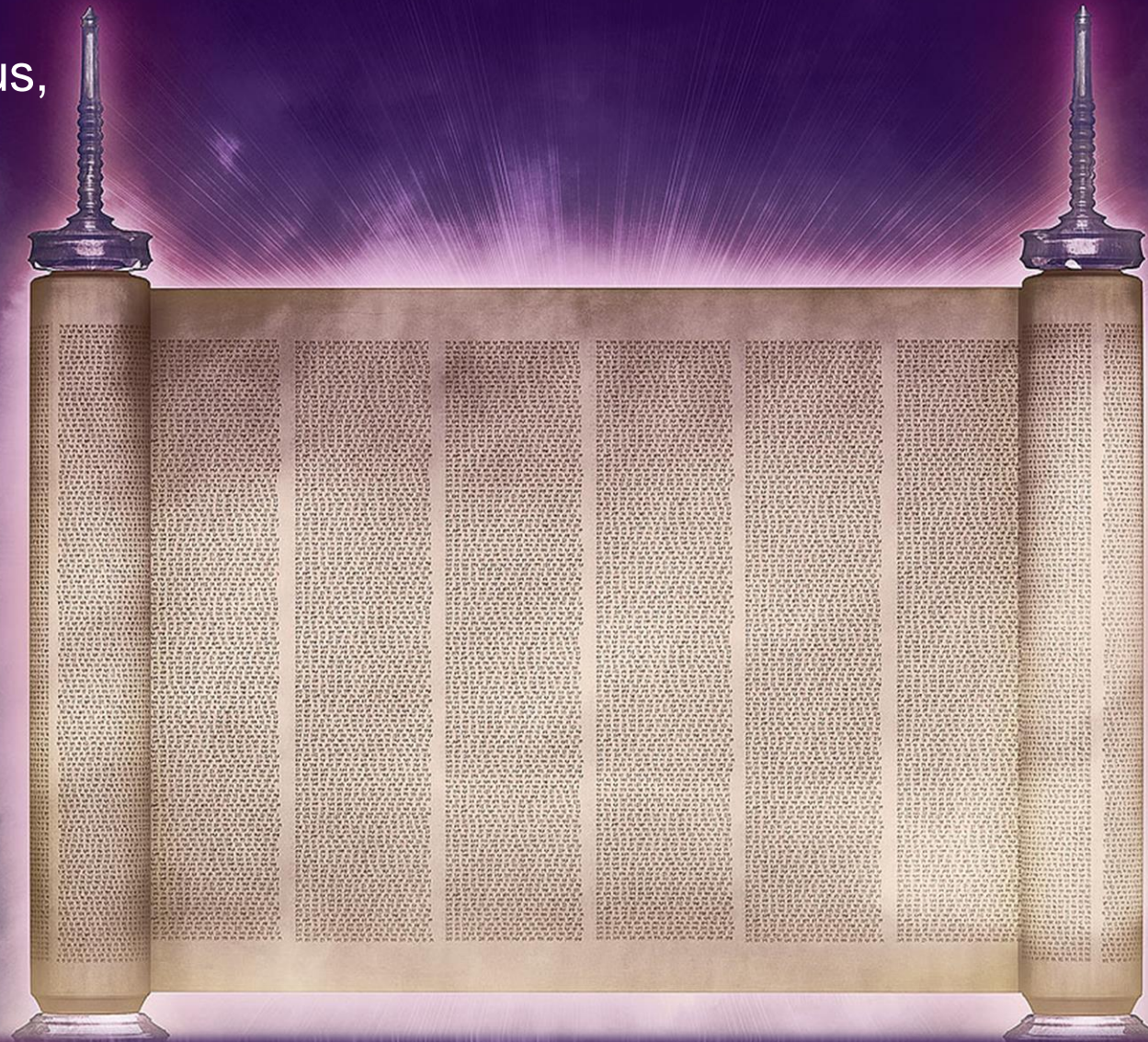
